

## Export References from Library Search

### Mac:

Items found using library search can be exported to EndNote, both individually and as a group. It is important to check your references in your EndNote library as some editing may be required.

### Individual item:


1. Leave your EndNote Library open.
2. Open your Internet browser and go to: <https://Library.sydney.edu.au/>.
3. Search for the item that you wish to export from Library Search on the Library Homepage.




4. Your search results will be displayed.
5. Click on the **show actions options** on the top pane.




6. Click on Export to **Endnote/RIS** from list.




7. A pop-up window will appear, select **Choose**.



8. Select **EndNote** application from the list




9. Tick on **Do this automatically for files like this from now on** to remember this setting for next time use.
10. Click **OK**.
11. Your selected references will be exported directly to EndNote. If not, it will ask you to select the export **filter** from EndNote filter list. Select **RefMan RIS** filter made by **Clarivate Analytics**



### Multiple References:

1. If you wish to export more than one item from the library search, then choose your references one at a time using **Keep this item option** by clicking the pin icon . Do this for all the references you wish to export to EndNote.






